



VISITORS PROGRAM

Based on the Rules of Procedure 2.1.9: *Visitors are people attending the Assembly part or full time. Normally these people are members of a member church, from which an endorsement is requested. They have neither voice nor vote.*

What is the LWF Assembly Visitors program?

It is a pre-arranged program for visitors of the LWF Assembly who have:

- interest to learn more about the LWF and its work
- interest to know more of the host church, The Evangelical Church of the Augsburg Confession in Poland, and visit the church and its programs some days before or after the assembly
- who are interested in observing the LWF Assembly in plenary, participate in worship (in an overflow room due to limited space in worship hall), visit the Jarmark (marketplace) and generally be together with the global Lutheran communion at the Assembly for a specific time.

Who can participate?

Eligible participants include members of the LWF member church and those coming from LWF related agencies and missions.

How to apply for the visitor's program?

Visitors will need to apply and fill up the registration form. The following information will be requested:

- the full name and contact information;
- the church and country from;
- specific period of visit;
- whether the delegation speaks English or will be using an interpreter, and whether the interpreter will provide simultaneous or consecutive translation;
- whether person applying or any member of the delegation has any disabilities or other needs that require reasonable attention

Some facts about the visitor's program:

- the Pre and Post assembly visitation programs will take place from 9-12 September and the post visits from 20-24 September 2023. Refer to separate document for the detailed program
- Daily visitors at the Assembly venue (ICE Krakow Congress Center) have to be pre-registered and ensure they receive confirmation from Assembly Office.
- There will be specific sessions and times open for visitors. Please refer to the list as stated below as some business sessions are internal to Assembly participants only.
- 80- 100 Day visitors will be welcomed each morning or afternoon time-block, except for the Opening Service where there would be more
- Visitors will have a dedicated area in the plenary hall marked visitors.
- Due to the limited space at the worship hall "watching livestream" of worship will take place in an overflow hall (except for the Opening Worship that takes place at the Plenary Hall

- The visits will be entirely self-supporting, and expenses charged to the visitors at cost
- When visitors arrive, they will be guided to the Registration desk for confirmation of registration and will be issued a badge. The badge will be a specific colour and display the date of visit/s.
